Dear Members,

Fish Stockings this season will take place on the following dates:

- 3/24/22 (weather permitting)
- 4/7/22
- 4/28/22

We start stocking around 4:30 pm, if anyone is interested in volunteering we can always use a extra hand even it's a little one. Butterball Trout Hatchery supply our fish, and have for years. They are reliable and the fish are always in perfect shape. Brook and rainbow trout will make up 90% the fish stocked with 12 to 14 inch minimum size up to 16 inches. Brown trout will make up the remaining percentage.

The Upper pond will be closed from 4/28/22 - 5/1/22, opening the day of the kids fishing derby. It will then be closed again till the John Shea's biggest trout derby on 5/8/22.

This year the kids fishing derby will be 5/1/22 from 9-11 AM, at the fly pond. Signup sheets will be on the message board in the bar. Maximum age is 15 years old. Members who do not have children feel free to bring any other family member within the age limit. Lunch is provided to all children participating. The kitchen will be open for adults to purchase food and drinks. We are always seeking donations to purchase additional prizes for the children at Derby, any amount would be greatly appreciated.

All fishermen and women must purchase a badge for \$25, which entitles them to hunt and fish. All Junior members must also purchase a badge for \$10, all badges available at the bar.

All ponds will open for fishing (catch and release) on 3/26/22 at 8 AM. Middle and skeet pond open for fishing (catch and keep) with a two fish limit 4/9/22 at 6AM.

Upper pond opens for fishing (catch and keep) May 7th after John Shea's Biggest Trout Derby.
